HVAC Inspection

PURPOSE: In January 2020, the Board of Directors adopted an HVAC inspection policy in response to damages sustained in owners' apartments and the common elements resulting from owners' failures to properly maintain or replace malfunctioning HVACs. This form is a complement to that policy and serves as guidance for inspection elements required by each owner's licensed, certified HVAC inspection provider.

SCOPE: This form is to be completed by a certified technician of the HVAC inspection firm. It should be submitted to the Office for retention in the unit files. The owner or the HVAC technician may submit this form Office.

VERSION: This is the first version of this form.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HVAC INSPECTOR: The purpose of AKW's annual inspection is to obtain a professional evaluation of the HVAC unit specifically to identify present or potential conditions that could cause damage to the owner's apartment or other apartments. The inspection program is not intended to ensure that each HVAC is fully functioning. The inspection should identify items that, in the inspector's professional opinion appear to be failing or about to fail. For each of the inspection points below the technician should state whether the item passes or does not pass the inspection.
